## WEATHER CONDITIONS

The year 2022 was marked by hot and dry weather.

The spring was marked by a strong frost episode in April which caused targeted losses on the Merlot.

The summer was particularly hot and sunny and produced wines with high degrees of alcohol but which were able to maintain a good balance between richness and freshness.

These climatic conditions will have an impact on our yields, which, as in 2022 and 2021, will be much lower than usual.

## THE HARVEST

The harvest took place from 19 September to 5 October. We harvested grapes of very good quality, very concentrated and with an exceptional maturity.

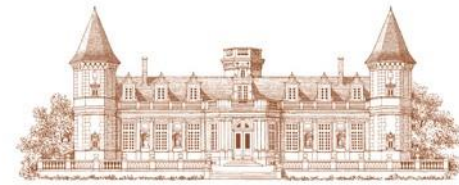
